



Dear Teachers,

We invite you to apply to be a teacher partner for TAI Seminar I: Bringing Your Art into the Classroom. This seminar is custom designed to meet the needs of performing and visual artists interested in developing an artist-in-residence program that aligns with the Maryland State Fine Arts Curriculum. We need teachers like you to work with an artist to help them develop, write, and field test this residency.



What it is...

- An intensive seminar limited to twenty professional artists and twenty teachers. Teachers who have completed MATI or other arts integration training have priority.
- A program that is custom-designed to meet the needs of the selected artists and improve the effectiveness of their residencies. This program is meant as a service to artists. Teacher partners who are selected and attend all required meetings will receive a stipend of \$300 for their time. In addition, teachers will have the benefit of hosting the residency field testing in their classroom at a cost of only \$100 to the school.

What we need...

We are seeking teachers who:

- Will attend TAI sessions with the artists (see schedule below)
- Will meet with the artist before, during & after the residency to advise (may be done through email).
- Will work with the artist to conduct a 4-workshop residency with one group of students in January/February 2010.
- Are willing to provide analysis and feedback of an artist-in-residence (1hr)

Evaluation Day – Certificate of completion distributed

If selected your school must provide:

- Letter of agreement signed by the principal and teacher that:
  - They will allow the teaching artist to teach a residency with one of your classes during school time
  - The school will contribute \$100 to the TAI program for the residency ( we will provide an invoice)
  - The school will contribute an additional \$100 if they are hosting a visual arts residency (for supplies)
