About Young Audiences / Arts for Learning

Young Audiences evolved out of the concern of arts patron Nina Wood Collier that young people were completing school and spending their lives without ever experiencing a live performance by a professional classical musician. She proceeded to organize the Young Musicians' Series in 1950, which included 20 concerts in Baltimore City schools. She had no idea that her actions would inspire 24 other states to form their own Young Audiences chapters.

Today, Maryland's own Young Audiences works with more than 100 professional artists and over 400 schools and community centers to present 2,800 live performances, hands-on workshops, artist residencies, and teacher trainings that serve nearly 240,000 students, educators and families. Young Audiences programs do more than provide high quality entertainment. They enliven school curriculum, increase students' interest in school, break down divisive cultural barriers and expand the horizons of our disadvantaged youth.
